Here Come the Bills!

BULLET

No, not the football team — they are not going anywhere this year. We're talking about the bills that are about to come pouring out of the Office of Legislative Services for the 2013 legislative session. At this writing, there are 820 active "legislative service requests" (LSRs), each of which will become a bill unless it is withdrawn.

The numbers on the LSRs, which can be found <u>here</u>, actually go up to 1006, but <u>112 LSRs have been withdrawn</u> to date, leaving fewer active ones. We realize those numbers still don't add up. Part of the difference is likely explained by the option legislators have of keeping LSR titles confidential until the bills are introduced; in addition, a few LSR titles are reserved for the state's operating budget and capital budget bills. When those additional LSRs are added, it seems likely that there will be close to 900 bills for the 2013 legislative session.

We have not seen any bills yet, but they are likely to start hitting the <u>legislature's web site</u> any day. When that happens, there should be a link to 2013 bills on the State Legislation Dash Board. If you can't wait for the link, you can do a <u>"quick bill search"</u> (also on the State Legislation Dash Board), enter 2013 for the session year, leave all other fields blank, and click on "submit." This will produce a list of all bills introduced for 2013. (If you do this right now, you will find ten bills, but these are merely House and Senate resolutions that deal with early housekeeping matters like adopting rules and setting salaries and mileage payments.)

As mentioned in last week's *Bulletin*, the House and Senate will each meet in session on Wednesday, January 2. After that, many hearings will be scheduled in rapid succession. Please check the House and Senate calendars this week and next, as well as next week's *Bulletin*, for hearing notices on bills of municipal interest.
