





Concord Fire Department

- Heavy soot throughout the building.






































Concord-Carlisle Highschool

- Fish tank fire on the fourth floor
- Fire activated sprinkler systems
- Water damage on all four levels including 12,000 square foot gymnasium
- ► Fire started 3 weeks before school was scheduled to start
- Concord-Carlisle Highschool enrolls 1,300 students each year

























Wellesley

- Required emergency response and extensive cleanup



















