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# What is Congressionally Directed Spending?



- > Criteria
  - Place-based
  - Short-term
  - Applicable to a certain number of eligible accounts
  - Subject to audit and transparency measures
- Using earmarks, Congress can make targeted investments in specific regions and direct funding for a multitude of uses:

- Education improvement
- Distance learning
- Rural broadband
- Agricultural research
- STEM research and education
- Conservation
- Health improvements

- Water infrastructure and watershed preservation
- Forest management
- Law enforcement technology
- Crime prevention
- Criminal justice improvements



### Different Chambers, Different Rules

	House	Senate
Total number of Eligible Accounts	41	60
Requires evidence of community support	Υ	N
Requires Members to prioritize requests	Υ	Depends on subcommittee
Limit on number of requests Members can submit	Υ	N
Requires hard copy of Member's certification letter	N	Υ

<sup>\*\*</sup>The table above shows a comparison of the House and Senate directed spending process (ref: Popvox Foundation). Please note that while the Senate Appropriations Committees does not require evidence of community support, this is a requirement for applicants submitting their proposals to the Office of Senator Shaheen.

- ➤ While some elements of the reformed process are similar, the House and Senate differ on the number of eligible accounts for CDS requests.
- House members may only submit 15 community development project requests. Senate members do not have this limitation.

### Commerce, Justice and Science



- Funds the Department of Commerce (DOC), the Department of Justice (DOJ) and several independent science agencies.
- The CJS Appropriations Subcommittee will accept CDS requests only for the following accounts:
  - National Institute of Standards and Technology (NIST);
     Scientific and Technical Research Services (STRS); External Projects;
  - NIST, Construction of Research Facilities; Extramural Construction
  - National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA);
     Operations, Research, and Facilities (ORF); Special Projects
  - Office on Justice Programs (OJP); State and Local Law Enforcement Assistance; Byrne Discretionary;
  - Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS); COPS Law Enforcement Technology;
  - NASA; Safety, Security and Mission Support



### Commerce, Justice and Science



Funds the Department of Commerce (DOC), the Department of Justice (DOJ) and several independent science agencies.

#### > Examples:

- Newington Emergency Communications Infrastructure: Senator Shaheen secured \$170,000 to fund the Town of Newington's efforts to upgrade their emergency communications equipment.
- Seacoast Science Center Renovation and Program
   Expansion: Senator Shaheen secured \$5,000,000 for the
   Seacoast Science Center to expand existing museum
   spaces and construct a new facility for their marine
   mammal rescue operations.

### Interior and Environment (I&E)



Funds the Department of the Interior, Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), U.S. Forest Service (USFS) and other agencies.

- ➤ The I&E subcommittee will accept congressionally directed spending requests for the following accounts:
  - Water and Wastewater Infrastructure: EPA, State and Tribal Assistance Grants, Water and Wastewater Infrastructure
  - Sanitation Facilities Construction: IHS, Sanitation Facilities Construction,
  - Historic Preservation Fund: NPS, Historic Preservation
     Fund
  - State and Private Forestry: USFS, State and Private Forestry, Forest Resource Information and Analysis



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#### > Items to Note:

- There is a <u>minimum</u> 20% cost share requirement for any state or local water infrastructure CDS grants.
- For State and Local Grants for Drinking or Clean Water Projects, Member offices must confirm:
  - ✓ Is the project on the state's most recently finalized Clean Water or Drinking Water State Revolving Fund Intended Use Plan?
  - ✓ If not, is the project eligible under State Revolving Loan Fund (SRF) guidelines?



### Transportation-Housing and Urban Development



Funds the Department of Transportation (DOT), the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and related agencies.

- ➤ The THUD Appropriations Subcommittee will accept CDS requests only for the following accounts:
  - Transportation Planning, Research, and Development (TPR&D)
  - Grants-in-Aid for Airports (Airport Improvement Program or AIP)
  - Highway Infrastructure Program (HIP)
  - Transit Infrastructure Grants (TIG)
  - Consolidated Rail Infrastructure and Safety Improvement (CRISI) Grants;
  - Economic Development Initiatives (EDI) for eligible economic development projects.



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#### > Examples:

- Housing for Youth and Young Adults: Senator Shaheen secured \$771,000 for this project that will fund Waypoint's work in Manchester to open the first ever emergency shelter and dedicated permanent housing units for youth and young adults in NH.
- West Cargo Apron Development: Senator Shaheen secured \$9,350,000 to support the Manchester-Boston Regional Airport's efforts to develop a 100,000 sq. ft. air cargo facility.

- ➤ When is your office's deadline?
  - The Shaheen office's appropriations deadline is <u>Friday, March 22<sup>nd</sup>.</u> Please be sure to submit all of your information by this date.
- > I submitted a CDS request to Representatives Kuster and Pappas. Can I submit one to Senator Shaheen as well?
  - Yes. We welcome all applications that meet the criteria requirements.
- > How do I know whether my project meets the eligibility requirements?
  - Information on CDS-eligible accounts can be found in the Shaheen CDS web portal.



### > I submitted my CDS request. What happens now?

- The Shaheen staff will review the information you provided to determine whether your request(s) meets our internal and committee criteria for submission as a formal CDS request from Senator Shaheen.
- We will notify you of our determination and keep you informed as the appropriations process moves forward



#### My project was not selected. What do I do?

 While your project may not be eligible for CDS funding, there are a number of federal resources available to fund economic development and community development projects.








Inflation Reduction Act


- \$1.9 trillion COVID-19 Relief
   Package
- Signed into law in March 2021
- \$550 billion in new infrastructure investments
  - Signed into law in November 2021
- \$370 billion in clean energy investments
- Signed into law in August 2022
