



I understand that I may only make such a request 14 days for candidates has closed, and that if I will not be absent on the date of the election I and le to vote by absentee ballot. □ I cannot appear in public on election day because of observance of a religious commitment. Date Returned: □ I am unable to vote in person due to a disability. I cannot appear at any time during polling hours at my polling place because an employment obligation requires me to remain physically at work or to be in transit to or from work from the time the polls open until after the time the polls close. Any person who votes or attempts to vote using an absentee ballot who is not entitled to vote by absentee ballot shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. RSA 657:24
